

FII Project Team Registration

Following are the requirements and guidelines for FII Project Team registration:

1. A project team should consist of **exactly 4 members** from PGP 2s, ABM 2s and FPM 2s and 3s (in any combination) and **exactly 1 member** from PGP 1/ABM1/FPM 1. The team would appoint 1 member as the **Team Leader**. The PGP 1/ABM1/FPM 1 member would join later (not in March 2011). It is mandatory to include a PGP 1/ABM1/FPM 1 after the new batch joins in June 2011.

2. A team has the choice of including 1 PGP X student as a **mentor** depending on their interaction which will be facilitated by FII. This will be done after summer internship.

3. A project team **should not consist of more than one member** going on an exchange program. The Team Leader can, under no circumstances, go on exchange. In the eventuality that there is more than 1 member leaving for exchange, the team will be dissolved and the members would be asked to register with a new team.

4. **Each non PGP1/ABM1/FPM 1 member** needs to deposit Rs. 1500 as caution money. This amount is totally refundable to the TEAM LEADER either on successful completion of the project **or** if the team does not win a project. Total amount of Rs. 6000 has to be submitted by the TEAM LEADER by **local** Cheque/Demand draft. The cheque book must be in **his/her own name**.

5. To register, please fill in the online form mentioned in the email. Please submit the hardcopy of the registration form with your Dorm FII representative. Deadline for registration of teams is **23:59:59 March 20, 2010 for both online and hard copy**.

6. Any registrations after the deadline will not be accommodated.

7. FII would not interfere in the team formation process and you can form teams of your choice. It is recommended to have some diversity in the team in terms of work-experience, academic background and gender.

8. Please go through the FII policy document very carefully and clarify any doubts with your Dorm FII representative by phone/e-mail/in person. We would recommend in person. The registration forms would require full knowledge of policies and commitment to abide by those policies.

9. If a member is part of two teams, registration of both the teams would be rejected.
